Hello students,

It's been an interesting few weeks to say the least. Moving forward I will be posting assignments on <a href="www.edpuzzle.com">www.edpuzzle.com</a> for most classes. I think most of you have used Edpuzzle at one point or another. For precalc and Integrated 1 there will be about 2 videos a week with corresponding assignments out of the textbook. For second period there will be one video lesson on edpuzzle a week and you will continue with your ALEKS lessons (yes, there will be knowledge checks). I will also be using the Remind app to stay in touch with all of you.

As we go forward please remember these few things:

- 1) Make sure your name and the assignment are written clearly at the top. Take a clear picture of all pages and email them to me.
- 2) As you watch the edpuzzle videos you will need a pencil (colored pencils can help too) and paper along with your textbook (I will be referencing it during the videos). Follow along writing down the examples just as you would take notes in class.
- 3) Please email me with any questions you have during the video.

Assignments will be posted on AERIES, <u>www.bonitahigh.net</u>, and <u>www.edpuzzle.com</u> each week on Monday. This week will be slightly different. Each class will only have one video (with corresponding assignment) and it will be posted by Wednesday 4/1/20 evening. You will also get credit for joining your edpuzzle and remind classes.

You can still turn in missed assignments for partial credit!!! Check AERIES assignments for details. When you sign up for edpuzzle make sure you use your school email address and legal name, no nicknames.

## Follow these instructions for joining your edpuzzle class:

- 1) Go to <a href="www.edpuzzle.com">www.edpuzzle.com</a> and set up an account. Remember to use your school email and legal name.
- 2) Use the following codes to join the correct class:
  - a. Period 1 hojcizf
  - b. Period 2 cacrent
  - c. Period 4 poritpe
  - d. Period 6 cialipe
  - e. Period 7 bebtipf
- 3) Make sure to check back after Wednesday evening to complete the first video.
- 4) I have used Edpuzzle before, and there have been times students had trouble watching a video. The vast majority of these were fixed by switching from either the Remind app to the website. If one didn't work, the other would.

## Follow these instructions for joining your remind class:

Precalculus: either text @9c7db3 to 81010 or go to rmd.at/9c7db3 (this will prompt you to download the remind app).

Integrated 1: either text @acce297 to 81010 or go to rmd.at/acce297 (this will prompt you to download the remind app).

SBAC review: either text @2gh2ade to 81010 or go to rmd.at/2gh2ade (this will prompt you to download the remind app).

I know this isn't an ideal situation by any mean, but I hope you use this time to improve your grade if needed and prepare for when things have returned to normal and we are back in class. Please reach out to me by email with any questions or concerns.
