Dear 11th Grade Students & Parents:

On March 1, 2023, the College Board is offering an opportunity for 11th grade students to take the SAT exam at their own school site during the school day, instead of a Saturday. To this end, the Bonita USD will pay for the cost of the <u>SAT exam</u> for any 11th grade student who wishes to take this exam on March 1st on the Bonita High School campus. This will provide 11th grade students a free one-time opportunity to complete the SAT Exam. Students will still be encouraged to take this exam again at their own cost either in June or the fall semester of senior year.

In order for us to adequately prepare for this exam, your student must **sign in through Google** (via school email) to this form. Register Here Registration must be completed by December 9 at 3:00 PM, or until registration reaches 280 students, whichever comes first. **Do not attempt to register on the College Board site for this exam.** These are the stipulations that students agree to:

- Students are responsible for making up all classwork for the day.
- All students taking the School Day SAT Exam on Wednesday, March 1, 2023 must complete all portions of the SAT and remain until the end.
- Students will not be admitted to the exam after the exam has begun.

UC will not consider SAT or ACT test scores when making admissions decisions or awarding scholarships. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll.

The California State University (CSU) no longer uses ACT or SAT examinations in determining admission eligibility for all CSU campuses. If accepted to a CSU campus, ACT or SAT test scores can be used as one of the measures to place students in the proper mathematics and written communication courses.
