CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITIES (CSU)

- Nation's largest university system with 23 great options
- Known for quality teaching and preparing job-ready graduates; “learn by doing” approach
- More affordable university education for California residents



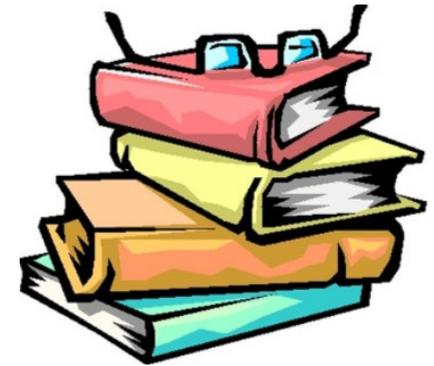
UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC)

- System of public research universities highly ranked worldwide
- 9 undergraduate campuses; theoretical approach
- Known for pioneering research, innovation, and discovery



A-G REQUIREMENTS *(SEE HANDOUT)*

- Both the UC's and CSU's utilize the A-G requirements.
- Sequence of required high school courses.
 - Minimum Grades of "C" or better in required subjects.
 - GPA / 10-12 Weighted GPA (*extra grade points limited to 8 semesters*)

A-G COURSE AREAS

- (A) History / Social Science *(2 years required)*
- (B) English *(4 years required)*
- (C) Mathematics *(3 years required / 4 recommended)*
- (D) Lab Science *(2 years required / 3 recommended)*
- (E) Language Other Than English *(2 years required / 3 recommended)*
- (F) Visual & Performing Arts *(1 year required)*
- (G) College Preparatory Elective *(1 year required)*



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Schools vary by size, selectivity/impaction, location, and majors offered

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Must meet CSU or UC Eligibility**

- Complete the A-G course requirements
- Each course should be completed with C- or better.
- Validation rules only apply in Math / LOTE (*CSU/UC*), and Chemistry (*CSU only*)
- Minimum GPA's may vary by campus or major
- **UC's – 3.0 min GPA**
- **CSU's – 2.5 min GPA** (2.0-2.49 for some less selective campuses w/ supplemental criteria)





SAT & ACT TESTING CHANGES / UPDATES

- **For Seniors**, the CSU & UC Campuses are not requiring or using the SAT or ACT for admission or scholarship purposes. Scores may only be used for placement purposes after the student has been admitted.
- **For 9th-11th grade**, the **UC** plans to continue not relying on SAT/ACT for admission.
- However, the **CSU** has temporarily suspended usage of SAT/ACT so stay tuned!
- **AP test scores** should still be reported on CSU & UC applications.
- **BHS will be offering a FREE SAT test for Juniors in March. Sign ups will be in December.**

CSU & UC IMPACTION (SEE HANDOUTS)



California State University

- 7 CSU campuses that are fully impacted (more selective) in all majors include: Fresno, Fullerton, Long Beach, Los Angeles, San Diego, San Jose, and San Luis Obispo.
- Other 16 CSU campuses may be less impacted at the first-time freshmen level depending on the major.

University of California

- Some UC campuses have much lower admit rates and higher average GPA's than other campuses, so apply broadly. For example, UCLA had a 10.8% admit rate and UC Merced had an 87.6% admit rate last year.
- UC's are also looking at number of A-G classes, rigor, extracurricular activities, leadership, community service, etc.

CAL POLY POMONA INFORMATION

- Cal Poly Pomona has slightly higher eligibility requirements for Out-of-Area students due to impaction.
(more than 20 programs impacted)
- **PERK!!** Local Area (BHS) students have admission priority to non-impacted majors; slight advantage for impacted major(s).



TO GET STARTED WITH APPLICATION (FOR SENIORS):

- Create email for college applications
- Create account with username and password at www2.calstate.edu/apply (CSU) or admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply (UC)
- Have following items available:
 - High school transcript
 - SSID: Statewide Student ID# on bottom left hand corner of transcript.
 - SAT/ACT (not required), AP Test Scores
 - Application fee \$70 (per campus)
 - Accept check, money order, credit / debit card, or fee waiver



CSU & UC APPLICATION INFO (SEE “SENIOR TIPS FOR CSU/UC” HANDOUT)



California State University

- Submit anytime between October 1 – November 30.
- **No personal statements** or essays for CSU, except for special programs or some scholarships.
- **No letters of recommendation**, except for EOP or some scholarships.
- Only send transcripts if requested; some campuses may request a **7th semester transcript** including the senior's grades from first semester.
- Choose a **first choice major** and an **alternate major** if allowed.

University of California

- Submit anytime between November 1 – November 30. Can start working on application in August.
- Answer 4 of 8 Personal Insight Questions (**PIQ's**)
- Complete **Activities & Awards** section of application.
- **No letters of recommendation**, except for some majors or scholarships. Sometime Berkeley will ask for one after the application has been submitted.
- 7th Semester transcripts are generally **not** requested.
- Choose a **first choice major** and **alternate major** if allowed.

APPLICATION FEE WAIVER

- You will be notified at the time you apply if you qualify.
- Upon qualification you are allotted a max of 4 fee waivers to the CSU or UC.
- Not based on school's free/reduced lunch program.



EOP – EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

Who might qualify?

- Low income
- First generation
- Historically disadvantaged students with academic potential for success
- Students must apply to EOP to qualify and provide the CSU with names/emails of two recommenders that can speak to your qualifications for the program.

What are some of the benefits?

- Summer transition programs
- Extra advisement
- Tutoring
- Skills development programs
- EOP Grant (part of financial aid)
